On the night of August 6–7, we were unexpectedly and profoundly saddened by the loss of our colleague, **Juan Carlos Flores Adame**, Civil Engineer and dedicated professional.

Juan Carlos was working on the road, supporting a project with a clearly marked escort vehicle, when he suffered a terrible accident. Despite the swift transfer to the hospital, the efforts of the doctors, and the work of all healthcare staff, his life was tragically lost in the operating room. His passing leaves not only a personal and professional void, but also a profound reflection on the risks faced daily by those who work on our roads.

Roads are dynamic and potentially dangerous environments. Workers involved — engineers, operators, escort drivers, signage and maintenance staff — are constantly exposed to risks due to vehicle speeds, low visibility at times, weather conditions, and, often, drivers who fail to respect safety rules.

The role of an escort vehicle, like the one **Juan Carlos** was driving, is precisely **to protect the safety of other workers and alert road users to the presence of construction zones or temporary hazards**. However, this essential work requires not only clear protocols and proper equipment but also **the commitment of society as a whole to respect and protect those who ensure our roads are safe**.

Juan Carlos Flores Adame was more than an engineer: he was a professional who understood that **each day on the road is a contribution to the well-being of thousands of people traveling our highways**. His dedication and sense of responsibility serve as an example to all of us. Honoring his memory means **strengthening our commitment to road safety** and the protection of every human life.

From the work and professional family we shared with Juan Carlos, we wish to express **our deepest condolences to his parents, relatives, and friends**. We know that no words can ease the pain of such a great loss, but we hope they feel the profound respect and affection that we all hold for him.
